Minimum length: 16, 14, 12 inches as described above (nose to fork of tail). Lengths are above minimum DLNR requirements.

- **Fish Quantity:** These are current DLNR and HI State rules and subject to change. All changes will be updated on the web site and reviewed at the competitors meeting.
  - -No more than twenty (20) fish total may be taken and weighed in.
  - -No more than recommended amount on fish list may be weighed in unless otherwise noted.
  - -Scoring is 1 (one) point per fish plus 1 (one) point per pound excepting that a single fish's points may not exceed 11 points (10 lb. plus 1 point for the fish).

### • Equipment:

- A. Spearguns all (including polespears) must be loaded using muscle power. No detonating or power heads may be used. Spearguns must be loaded and unloaded in the water. Having a loaded speargun out of the water is grounds for a DQ. Due to limited visibility, NO free shafts. All shafts must be tethered.
- B. A 1.8 3 mm wetsuit is recommended.
- C. **Required:** A dive flag shall be mounted on each dive board a minimum of (12"X14"), and each board will be numbered.

#### • Paddleboards/Kayaks:

Paddleboards/kayaks or float propulsion shall be powered by manual methods only. This includes hand paddling, kicking (foot fins) and paddles. No mechanized or other means of non-manual propulsion is allowed.

#### • Miscellaneous Rules:

- A) There shall be no chumming. Chumming includes willfully breaking up the bottom and removing or damaging any shellfish or fin fish in order to attract other fish. No feeding (chumming) of fish in the tournament area 30 days prior to or during competition.
- B) Divers may assist respective team members but may not assist divers of another team except in cases of emergency. Assisting or receiving assistance from another diver would include the following: sending signals, lending equipment and/or resting on another diver's float. Divers must take their own fish; no trading or giving of fish to other divers is allowed. All fish taken must remain separate from other divers catches. Upon arriving at the staging area each divers catch will be bagged and tagged.
- C) All divers MUST have turned in a signed a waiver. If no waiver is turned in, the diver fish will not be weighed and he/she will be disqualified
- D) No artificial breathing apparatus may be used.
- E) Violation of any Hawaii Fish and Game rules will result in disqualification.
- F) No use of alcohol or rough play.

#### • Diving Areas:

- A) The tournament boundaries will be marked by north and south buoys. The northern tournament boundary is a line from which is approximately 80 feet of water to a point on shore at which has a true course of 270 degrees when you look seaward. The southern tournament boundary is a line from which is in roughly 80 feet of water to a point on shore at which has a true course of 270 degrees when you look seaward. Each boundary is about 1.5 miles from middle of starting point.
- B) Competitors must enter and exit the water from the staging area only. There will be two large marked buoys.
- C) Competitors may only leave the diving (meet) area during competition with permission from a judge or safety boat except in an emergency.
- D) No fish may be taken in the meet area starting from July 1.
- E) No competitor may possess a speargun or polespear in the meet area from July 1<sup>st</sup> until the tournament day.
- F) No competitor's catch may leave the staging area until s/he has weighed his/her catch and signed an acceptance of weigh form.
- G) Buoys will clearly mark the water start and finish line and all divers must be inside the buoys before the start and will be disqualified if returning past the 3:00 finish time.
- H) Competitors may dive in the meet area up to the day before the competition when, at 5:00 p.m., they must be out of the tournament area. Divers shall not re-enter the water in the meet area on the day of the meet prior to its start.

- Women's and/or Mixed "Team" trophies: places 1-3 (6 total trophies) per division
- Men's Individual High Aggregate score trophies places 1-5 All American Team
- Women's Individual High Aggregate score places 1-3
- Men's Large Fish
- Women's Large Fish
- Men's Novice Diver of Tournament

All competitors will receive an official patch set signifying participation in this event.
